June was a great month this year. The numbers of volunteers coming to San Cristobal Island increasing, which is excellent for our children, conservation activities and the community. The work of Projects Abroad volunteers is having a very positive impact on local tourism and bringing in much needed money to help our people. We have started our own creative art project in our center, instead of working in the local school system, and have courses such as art, recycled art, painting and dance. Conservation continues to be a very strong project since we help the officials in the Galapagos National Park look after the giant tortoises and protect the unique bird, the Galapagos petrel. are helping to protect its nesting areas by getting rid of rats and wild cats, in one of the areas of the island that has limited access by the local people. We have been clearing vegetation and moving nests to help protect the eggs and young birds. Our new English programme is also successful and easier to teach because we have new materials that also help with testing and placing students in the correct levels. In addition, we have signed an agreement with local education officials so that our volunteers can work in the local system without any problems. 
